Description: In the village of Kundus, Falah Hospital has no maternity ward.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Partnered with PEARL (Canada), Fiysabiylillah raised funds to set up and staff a maternity ward and to provide practical midwifery training for 3 students.

2012: Development Project - Somaliland

Project Type: Reservoirs and Educational
Facilities

Description: In the villages of Kulmiye and Kalwarabe, proper educational facilities are needed.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Raises the funds for the construction of 2 educational centres and reservoirs.



2013: Industrial Aid - Sri Lanka





Project Type: Business Assistance

Description: Refugee families in
North Sri Lanka require assistance to
purchase the equipment necessary to work.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: 3 new, heavy duty, industrial sewing machines are funded by Fiysabiylillah and given to families to become self-sufficient.

2013: Healthcare Project - Pakistan

Project Type: Medical Assistance

Description: Baltistan is a remote area of Pakistan with unmaintained roads and no fully operated hospital. The people are deprived of proper healthcare facilities.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Assisted in raising \$50,000 CDN to train staff and provide better facilities and services.



2004: Community Project - Burundi



Project Type: Education

Description: In a small community in Burundi, the residents require a place

to meet and acquire knowledge.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Provided the funds necessary to finance this project.

2005: Flood Relief - Guyana

Project Type: Disaster Relief

Description: In January, 40% of Guyana was covered with flood waters. About 70,000 households were affected.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Food, clothing and medical supplies were shipped. Financial aid was also sent to restore masjids.



2005: Start-up Library - Guyana



Project Type: Education

Description: In some parts of the world, books are not free. Without family to support them, Guyana's orphans have little access to literature.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Donated 75 books each to 3 separate orphanages.

2006: Earthquake Relief - Pakistan

Project Type: Disaster Relief

Description: In October of 2005, an earthquake, magnitude 7.6, hit Kashmir and parts of Pakistan. The devastation is instant.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: 75 boxes of clothing are donated to help the survivors.

2006: Widows & Orphans Sponsorship Program - Pakistan

Project Type: Family Support

Description: In the Village of Rakh Minar Garh in Pakistan, some widowed women and their children struggle to obtain the bare necessities required to subsist.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Commits to help those families until their children reach the age of sixteen.



2006: School Enhancement - Uganda



Project Type: Education

Description: Maato Muslim Primary School needed to upgrade their facility to make it more conducive to learning.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Provided desks, benches and a fence to make the learning experience more comfortable and safe for the children.

2006: Water Tanks - Kenya

Project Type: Disaster Relief

Description: North-East Kenya suffered a terrible drought affecting 5 million people.

What Fiysabiylillah did to help: Financed 10 water tanks, which were delivered and installed with the assistance of the Ummah Foundation.



2007-2008: School Project - Nigeria



Project Type: Education

Description: In Lagos, an educational facility is needed to teach young students both academic and religious knowledge.
